### FIRST DAY STARTING TIMES

**Junior College (Preparatory to Year 4)** 

**8:00am** arrival for an 8:30am start. Students are required to go straight into their class:

Prep - JC Block

Year 1 - JB Block
Year 2 - JA Block
Year 4 - JE Block

### Middle and Senior College (Years 5 to 12)

**8:00am** arrival to locate Home Room and meet the Home Group teacher.

Years 5 to 12 Students will meet with their Home Group Teacher from 8.20am.

During the day, students will attend a year level meeting to discuss the exciting year ahead and meet with their new Head of Year (HOY).

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **HOW WILL I KNOW WHERE TO GO?**

**Preparatory to Year 4** (including New Students)

Class lists and classroom locations will be displayed at the Year Level blocks and outside the Student Services office.

### Years 5 to 12

Parents will be able to access their child's home group class allocation via iLINQ from **Wednesday 22 January 2025**.

### New Students - Years 5 and 6

8:00am arrival to locate Home Room and meet the Home Group teacher.

### New Students - Year 7

Gather at The Pavilion where students will meet with their allocated buddies and Home Group Teachers before moving to their home group classes.

### New Students - Years 8 to 12

Meet their Home Group teacher at the Home Group Classroom. Home Group teachers will then introduce new students to their buddies.

#### **Current Students - Years 5 to 12**

Class Lists and Home Room locations for Middle and Senior College will be displayed outside Student Services.

### WHAT DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BRING?

### **Kindergarten to Year 4 Students**

Students will already have their stationery supplies delivered to their classrooms. They will only need to bring their morning tea, lunch, water bottle and play hat.

Students in Year 4 will need to bring their BYOD laptop.

#### Years 5 to 12 Students

Students from Years 5 to 12 will be able to view their timetable via iLINQ from **Wednesday 22 January 2025.** They will attend their **Period 4 and 5 classes** on the first day of College.

### WHAT DOES MY CHILD NEED TO WEAR?

All students must attend in their formal uniform including dress hat (no blazer required) with an appropriate haircut or style.


Should your child not adhere to our policies and College expectations, we will talk with them at school and be in touch with you during the College Day.

## WILL THE COLLEGE BUS CHARTER SERVICE BE OPERATING?

Yes. Sheldon College offers privately run bus routes to a number of surrounding areas. This service will operate from the first day of College.

# WILL BEFORE AND AFTER COLLEGE CARE BE OPERATING?

### STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARDS

### **Current Students**

Current students are reminded not to dispose of their 2024 Student ID cards over the holidays\*. These will remain valid until the new 2025 ID cards are issued at the end of Term 1.

Students are required to bring their ID cards to College on the first day of Term 1 to enable them to borrow their text books from the Library and purchase items from Café 97.

\* Replacement cards will need to be ordered through the College Finance Department if students lose or throw out their current card. A replacement card will incur a charge.

#### **New Students**

We will take your child's photograph as soon as possible following their commencement in Term 1, 2025.

Until your child's ID card has been issued, you will be unable to use Sheldon Pay for students in Years 5 to 12 and you will need to provide your child with a packed morning tea and lunch or with cash to purchase items at Café 97.

You can still use Sheldon Pay for online ordering for students in Preparatory to Year 4.
