MINIMUM DEVICE SPECIFICATIONS

Physical Dimensions	Screen Size: 13" (Minimum)
Operating System	Windows 11 (ICT will be able to assist with upgrading the OS to Pro/Education) MacOS 14.0.X
Wireless Compatibility	Must be compatible with 802.11ac (WiFi 5) or 802.11ax (WiFi 6)
Battery Life	Minimum of 6 to 8 hours of battery life (Device to be charged each night)
Security Software	Windows 11 includes Windows Defender MacOS Gatekeeper (Optional)
Storage, RAM and Processor	Minimum 256GB SSD Storage, 8GB RAM and Intel Core i3, Apple Silicon (M1/M2)
User Account	Must be Local Administrator
Hardware Features	Camera, Microphone & Earphone Port USB connectivity (USB3/USB-C), Physical Keyboard

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

The following are not requirements of the BYOD program, but should be considered:

Internet Filtering/VPN	If internet filtering software and/or VPN software is installed on the device, it should not be used on our College Network.
Protection	Protective Case and Cover Accidental Loss and Breakage Insurance
Media, Music and Design Technologies	Students intending to select a Media, Music or Design Technologies subject in Years 9+ should consider upgrading to 16GB RAM and an i7 Processor. Please refer to your local retailer for technical guidance.
