TERM FEES INCLUDE:

- Tuition
- Standard Excursions
- Textbook Hire
- Compulsory Camps at the commencement of the new school year.
- Specialist Subject Excursion Programs may attract additional charges.

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NON-TUITION COSTS INCLUDE:

- The **Enrolment Acceptance Fee** is payable when a placement has been offered by the College and accepted by the Family and is non-refundable except in the event of visa refusal.
- Medical Insurance – a student is required to have sufficient health cover for the duration of their studies in Australia. The cost provided is an indicative charge only.
- Book Packs, stationery, and personal equipment, e.g., calculator costs must be met by the student.
- Uniform costs must be covered by the student.
- QCAA Fee – charged by the Queensland Curriculum & Assessment Authority for completion of the Queensland Certificate of Education in Years 11-12. Price is exclusive of GST and is subject to change.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT HOMESTAY FEES:

- The Homestay Bond is refundable as per the conditions of enrolment.
- A Homestay Placement fee is charged if students request a change in homestay.
- Homestay Fees are invoiced in advance and per Term. If necessary, any adjustments will be made in the following term.
- Whilst absent from homestay during school holidays, fees will be charged at the full rate if student is absent for less than 14 days of the holidays. Homestay fees will be charged at 50% rate if the student is absent for over 14 days of the holidays. Homestay fees will only be charged at the reduced rate if advice is handed into the Finance Office in writing prior to the student's departure.
- Airport Pick Up/Airport Drop Off/Transportation fee between new homestays is charged as applicable.
- Bank Payment Fee is applicable if transferring from an international account.

HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION INCLUDES:

- Own Bedroom
- Desk
- Lamp
- Cupboard/drawers
- Three meals per day
- Laundry

Students may be required to purchase additional internet usage or purchase their own internet access.

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SUNDRY EXTRA CHARGES

Sundry extra charges are charges for activities related to the curriculum in which the overseas student is a participant. These fees are itemised on fees invoices for those students / families who elect to benefit from their provision. These include:

- Specialist Sporting Programs
- Instrumental Music lessons
- Private tutoring
- Transportation fees to and from the College via the College bus services are to be covered by the family of the student.

Parents are required to give permission for a student's involvement in any elective activity by way of liaising with the relevant specialist department at the College or acceptance via Events and Payments in Parent Lounge. Sundry Extra Charges are payable upon the issue of an invoice by the Chief Financial Officer or provided with costs in Parent Lounge.

CONDITIONS

- Fees are payable one Term in advance.
- Cheques are to be made payable to Sheldon College International Trust Account.
- If fees are not paid before the commencement of each Term, enrolment may be cancelled.
- Fees for Overseas Students are reviewed annually.
- If an application for enrolment is accepted by the College, all fees detailed in the fees invoice are payable within 30 days. A Confirmation of Enrolment will not be issued until fees are paid in full and all enrolment processes are completed.

Fees and charges are listed in Australian dollars (AUD). Fees may be subject to change.
